

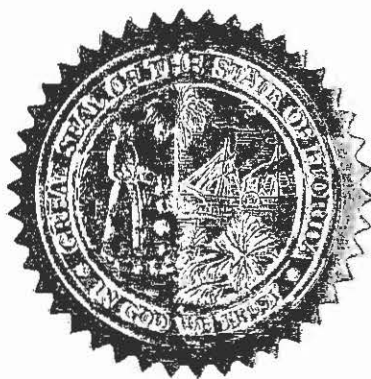

EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 12-132

WHEREAS, Joseph O. Ellis, member of the Loxahatchee River Environmental Control District, Area 4, died on November 8, 2011; and

WHEREAS, Article X, Section 3, of the Florida Constitution, and Section 114.01(1)(b), Florida Statutes, provide that a vacancy in office shall occur upon the death of an incumbent officer; and

WHEREAS, Section 114.01(2), Florida Statutes, provides that the Governor shall file an Executive Order with the Secretary of State setting forth the facts that give rise to a vacancy in office;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, declare that due to the death of Joseph O. Ellis, a vacancy exists in the Loxahatchee River Environmental Contract District, Area 4, which I shall fill in compliance with the law.
