## OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 12-137 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 12-116)

WHEREAS, the Honorable PETER ANTONACCI, State Attorney for the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 12-116, to the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Tasha Leslie for possession with intent to sell methamphetamines and oxycodone, possession with intent to sell drugs within school grounds, engine running/key in ignition and driving while license suspended; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable MICHAEL J. SATZ, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that Tasha Leslie has subsequently been arrested for grand theft auto; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable PETER ANTONACCI, State Attorney for the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charge in this matter; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.


Executive Order 12-116 is hereby amended to include the additional charge of grand theft auto.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 12-116 is ratified and reaffirmed.
