EXECUTIVE OFFICE OF THE GOVENOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 12-164

WHEREAS, by Executive Order Number 12-90, Christopher P. Dzadovsky was suspended from his public office as Chairman of the St. Lucie County Board of County Commissioners and Commissioner for District 1; and

WHEREAS, the suspension ordered by Executive Order Number 12-90 was predicated upon commission of a felony, in particular an arrest warrant charging Christopher P. Dzadovsky with third-degree grand theft pursuant to section 812.014(2)(c), Florida Statutes, a third-degree felony; and

WHEREAS, on July 18, 2012, the State Attorney for the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit filed an amended information changing the felony grand theft charge to a misdemeanor petit theft charge, based upon new information related to the value of the stolen property, leaving no felony charge intact.

NOW THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, pursuant to Article IV, Section 7, Florida Constitution, issue this Executive Order, effective immediately:

1. Christopher P. Dzadovsky is hereby reinstated to the public office that he held at the time of the above-mentioned suspension, to-wit: Chairman of the St. Lucie County Board of County Commissioners and Commissioner for District 1; and

2. Executive Order 12-90 is hereby revoked and the suspension of Christopher P. Dzadovsky is terminated.
