## OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR

### EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 12-167

WHEREAS, the people of the State of Florida, by constitutional amendment, have declared that a public office is a public trust and the people have a right to secure and sustain that trust against abuse; and

WHEREAS, the Commission on Ethics of the State of Florida has been created to represent the people in assuring that public officers do not abuse trust placed in them; and

WHEREAS, James E. Flynt, is at all times material hereto a former member of the City Commission of the City of Bunnell, Florida, and as such was subject to the provisions of the Code of Ethics for Public Officers and Employees, Part III of Chapter 112, Florida Statutes, and within the jurisdiction of the State of Florida Commission on Ethics; and

WHEREAS, the Commission on Ethics concluded that Mr. Flynt violated Section 112.313(6), Florida Statutes, by disposing of used tires at a City dumpster; and

WHEREAS, the Commission on Ethics concluded that Mr. Flynt violated Section 112.313(3), Florida Statutes, by doing business with the City; and

WHEREAS, the Commission on Ethics concluded that Mr. Flynt violated Section 112.313(7)(a), Florida Statutes, by having a conflicting employment or contractual relationship regarding the City; and

WHEREAS, the Governor accepts the findings, conclusions, and recommendations of the Commission on Ethics Final Order and Public Report dated June 20, 2012;

NOW THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my constitutional duty to take care that the laws be faithfully executed, and pursuant to the

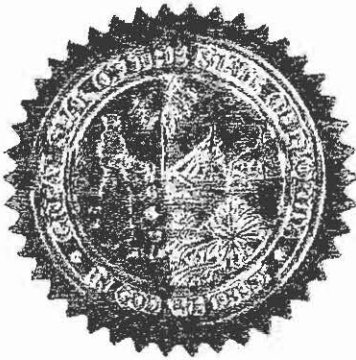
Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue this Executive Order effective immediately finding that:

1. James E. Flynt violated Section 112.313(6), Florida Statutes, by disposing of used tires at a City dumpster.


2. James E. Flynt violated Section 112.313(3), Florida Statutes, by doing business with the City.

3. James E. Flynt violated Section 112.313(7)(a), Florida Statutes, by having a conflicting employment or contractual relationship regarding the City.

4. A civil penalty in the amount of \$2,500.00 is hereby imposed against Mr. Flynt which penalty shall be satisfied within thirty (30) days of the date of this order. Payment must be submitted with a written statement made under oath by Mr. Flynt that the penalty was not paid with public funds and will not be reimbursed with public funds.
