OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 12-195 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 12-110, AMENDED BY EXECUTIVE ORDER 12-125)

WHEREAS, the Honorable EARL MORELAND, State Attorney for the Twelfth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 12-110, to the Twentieth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges of burglary of a dwelling, grand theft, and dealing in stolen property and driving on a suspended license pending against Megan Demonbreun, and amended by Executive Order 12-125 to include additional charges of grand theft, grand theft auto, giving false verification to a pawn shop and dealing in stolen property pending against Megan Demonbreun; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable STEPHEN B. RUSSELL, State Attorney for the Twentieth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that there are now allegations that Harry Lewis Claridy is a co-defendant of Megan Demonbreun's in the crimes of burglary of a dwelling and grand theft; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable EARL MORELAND, State Attorney for the Twelfth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment including the allegations pending against Harry Lewis Claridy; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.


Executive Order 11-110, amended by Executive Order 12-125, is hereby amended to include allegations against co-defendant Harry Lewis Claridy for burglary of a dwelling and grand theft.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 11-110, amended by Executive Order 12-125, is ratified and reaffirmed.
