OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 12-230 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 12-227)

WHEREAS, on October 9, 2012, Executive Order 12-227 was issued assigning the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit to handle a case against James Todd Murphy; and

WHEREAS, a scrivener's error occurred advising the period of the executive assignment would be for one year, to and including October 9, 2012, when the correct date is October 9, 2013; and the state attorney shall notify this office on or before September 9, 2012, if additional time is required, when the correct date is September 9, 2013; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 12-227 is hereby amended to reflect that the period of the executive assignment is for one year, to and including, October 9, 2013, and the assigned state attorney shall notify the Governor on or before September 9, 2013, if additional time is required.


Section 2.


Except as amended herein, Executive Order 12-227 is ratified and reaffirmed.
