EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 12-251

WHEREAS, Kelly Waterman Johnson was appointed to the Manatee Housing Authority on November 10, 1998; and

WHEREAS, Article X, Section 3, of the Florida Constitution, and Section 114.01(1)(f), Florida Statutes, provide that a vacancy in office shall occur upon the officer's unexplained absence for sixty consecutive days; and

WHEREAS, Kelly Waterman Johnson last attended a meeting of the Manatee Housing Authority on February 7, 2007; and

WHEREAS, Kelly Waterman Johnson's sixtieth day of unexplained consecutive absence from office occurred on April 8, 2007; and

WHEREAS, Section 114.01(2), Florida Statutes, provides that the Governor shall file an Executive Order with the Secretary of State setting forth the facts that give rise to a vacancy in office;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, declare that due to Kelly Waterman Johnson's sixty days of unexplained consecutive absence from office as a commissioner on the Manatee Housing Authority, a vacancy exists on the Manatee Housing Authority, Seat 5.
