OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 12-265

WHEREAS, Executive Order 12-84 assigned the Honorable MICHAEL J. SATZ, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, to the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit to discharge the duties of the State Attorney relating to charges against Kevin Dimitri Sleem for violations of probation; and

WHEREAS, the original executive assignment was requested because State

Attorney Michael F. McAuliffe was the victim in the case and the subsequent violations
of probation were resulting from the original executive assignment; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable PETER ANTONACCI was subsequently appointed

State Attorney for the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit and has advised that a conflict no longer exists because Michael F. McAuliffe is no longer state attorney; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the State of Florida to dissolve Executive Order 12-84;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby promulgate the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 12-84 is hereby dissolved.
