EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 13-114

(Executive Order of Removal)

WHEREAS, on December 13, 2012, the State Attorney for the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit filed an information in the County Court of the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit, in and for Palm Beach County, Florida, charging Linda Johnson, Commissioner and Vice Mayor on the South Bay City Commission, with public-meeting violation, as prohibited by section 286.011(3)(b), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, on December 19, 2012, by Executive Order 12-281, Governor Rick Scott suspended Linda Johnson from her position as Commissioner and Vice Mayor on the South Bay City Commission, pursuant to the Governor's suspension powers under section 112.51, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, on April 12, 2013, the Court found Linda Johnson guilty as charged, and adjudicated her guilty;


WHEREAS, section 112.51(5), Florida Statutes, provides that the Governor shall remove a municipal official who is convicted of any charge contained in an information by reason of which the official was suspended, under the provisions of section 112.51.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, pursuant to section 112.51, Florida Statutes, issue the following executive order, effective immediately:

Section 1. Linda Johnson is hereby removed from public office, to wit:
Commissioner and Vice Mayor on the South Bay City Commission, Florida.
