## OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 13-120

WHEREAS, by Executive Order Number 12-282, Shirley Walker-Turner was suspended from her office as City Commissioner for the City of South Bay, Florida effective December 21, 2012, based on a December 13, 2012 Information lodged by the State Attorney for the Fifteenth Circuit charging her with a Sunshine Law violation, as prohibited by section 286.011(3)(b), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, notwithstanding that suspension, the voters of South Bay elected Shirley Walker-Turner to a seat on the City Commission in a special election held on May 14, 2013.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, pursuant to section 112.51, Florida Statutes, issue this Executive Order:

Section 1. Executive Order Number 12-282 is revoked and the suspension of Shirley Walker-Turner is set aside.

Section 2. Shirley Walker-Turner is temporarily reinstated as a City Commissioner for the City of South Bay, effective immediately. This reinstatement is dependent upon the outcome of the charge of Sunshine Law violation contained within the Information filed on December 13, 2012. At the conclusion of that case, Shirley Walker-Turner will either be permanently reinstated or removed from office, by subsequent order.
