EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 13-131
(Executive Order of Removal)

WHEREAS, Annelise Muniz, is presently serving as a Notary Public of the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, on June 15, 2012, Annelise Muniz was adjudicated guilty of trafficking in cannabis, a violation of section 893.135(1)(a), Florida Statutes, in case number 2011-010435A-CF, which constitutes a first-degree felony; and

WHEREAS, section 112.52(3), Florida Statutes, authorizes the Governor to remove a public official convicted of any felony; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the citizens of the State of Florida, that Annelise Muniz be immediately removed from the public office, which she now holds, upon the grounds set forth in this executive order;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, pursuant to section 112.52(3), Florida Statutes, issue the following executive order, effective immediately:

Section 1. Annelise Muniz is hereby removed from the public office of Notary Public.


