

# STATE OF FLORIDA

## OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 13-16

WHEREAS, the Honorable DAVID A. ARONBERG, State Attorney for the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has advised Governor RICK SCOTT that C.I. and I.M., juveniles, have been [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] William Vassor has been charged four counts of burglary of a dwelling, burglary of an occupied dwelling, two counts of grand theft, possession of burglary tools and loitering or prowling; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable DAVID A. ARONBERG has also advised the victims are the parents of an employee of the state attorney's office; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable DAVID A. ARONBERG, to avoid any appearance of conflict of interest or impropriety, has voluntarily disqualified himself and has requested the executive assignment of another State Attorney with respect to the investigation and potential prosecution of this case and all related matters; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable BRUCE H. COLTON, State Attorney for the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept an executive assignment in this matter; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the State of Florida and of the ends of justice that the Honorable BRUCE H. COLTON discharge the duties of the Honorable DAVID A. ARONBERG, pursuant to Section 27.14, Florida Statutes;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue the following Executive Order, effective immediately:

Section 1.

The Honorable BRUCE H. COLTON, State Attorney for the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, referred to as the "Assigned State Attorney," is assigned to discharge the duties of the Honorable DAVID A. ARONBERG, State Attorney for the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, as they relate to investigation and potential prosecution and all matters related to juveniles C.I. and I.M. and William Vassor.

Section 2.

The Assigned State Attorney or one or more Assistant State Attorneys and Investigators, who have been designated by the Assigned State Attorney, shall proceed immediately to the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, and are vested with the authority to perform the duties prescribed herein.

Section 3.

All residents of the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit are requested, and all public officials are directed, to cooperate and render whatever assistance is necessary to the Assigned State Attorney, so that justice may be served.

Section 4.

The period of this Executive Assignment shall be for one (1) year, to and including January 31, 2014.

Section 5.

The Assigned State Attorney shall notify the Governor on or before December 31, 2013, if additional time is required.
