OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 13-236 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 13-205)

WHEREAS, the Honorable GLENN HESS, State Attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 13-205, to the First Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Andrew Patrick Ziebell for obtaining a controlled substance by fraud and trafficking and in a separate case for six counts of obtaining a controlled substance by fraud and six counts of trafficking; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable WILLIAM EDDINS, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that Andrew Patrick Ziebell has an additional charge of obtaining controlled substance by fraud; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable GLENN HESS, State Attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charge in this matter; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.


Executive Order 12-205 is hereby amended to include the additional charge of obtaining controlled substance by fraud.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 12-205 is ratified and reaffirmed.
