### EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 13-269

#### (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 13-227)

WHEREAS, the Honorable WILLIAM EDDINS, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 13-227, to the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Michael Jerome Ford for driving under the influence and violation of probation in two separate cases; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable GLENN HESS, State Attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that Michael Jerome Ford has been charged with aggravated battery; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable WILLIAM EDDINS, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charge of aggravated battery; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

#### Section 1.


Executive Order 13-227 is hereby amended to include the additional charge of aggravated battery.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 13-227 is ratified and reaffirmed.
