**EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 13-283**  
**(Emergency Management-Terminating Executive Order 13-282)**

WHEREAS, on October 3, 2013, I issued Executive Order 13-282 due to the threat of Tropical Storm Karen to the State of Florida, and declared a state of emergency in 18 counties; and

WHEREAS, the conditions warranting a state of emergency as it relates to Tropical Storm Karen have now ceased to exist.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, as Governor of Florida, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Florida Constitution and by the Florida Emergency Management Act, as amended, and all other applicable laws, promulgate the following Executive Order, to take immediate effect:

Section 1. Executive Order 13-282 is terminated as of this date.

Section 2. Nothing in this Order shall be construed to affect the validity of any action taken or obligation incurred in reliance upon Executive Order 13-282 while in effect.
