**EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 13-346**  
(Executive Order of Removal)

**WHEREAS**, Rasamay Mazumder, is presently serving as a Notary Public of the State of Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, on or about November 13, 2012, Rasamay Mazumder was convicted in the circuit court of the Fourth Judicial Circuit of Florida in and for Clay County in case number 2012CF001334 of Sale, Manufacture, Delivery or Possession with Intent to Sell, Manufacture or Deliver a Controlled Substance, a second-degree felony offense pursuant to Section 893.13(1)(a)1., Florida Statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, on or about July 23, 2013, Rasamay Mazumder was convicted in the circuit court of the Fourth Judicial Circuit of Florida in and for Clay County in case number 2013CF000825 of Possession of a Controlled Substance with Intent to Sell, Manufacture or Deliver, a second-degree felony offense pursuant to Section 893.13(1)(a)1., Florida Statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, a public official convicted of a felony offense may be removed from office by executive order of the Governor, pursuant to Section 112.52(3), Florida Statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interests of the citizens of the State of Florida, that Rasamay Mazumder be immediately removed from the public office, which he now holds, upon the grounds set forth in this executive order.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, pursuant to section 112.52(3), Florida Statutes, issue the following executive order, effective immediately:

Section 1. Rasamay Mazumder is hereby removed from the public office of Notary

Public.
