EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 13-348

(Executive Order of Removal)

WHEREAS, Matthew Bunce, is presently serving as a Notary Public of the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, on or about November 18, 2013, Matthew Bunce was convicted of child neglect without harm, a third-degree felony, in violation of Section 827.03(3)(c) Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Section 112.52(3), Florida Statutes, provides that any public official convicted of a felony offense may be removed from office by executive order of the Governor; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the citizens of the State of Florida, that Matthew Bunce be immediately removed from the public office, which he now holds, upon the grounds set forth in this executive order.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, pursuant to section 112.52(3), Florida Statutes, issue the following executive order, effective immediately:

Section 1. Matthew Bunce is hereby removed from the public office of Notary Public.
