EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 13-358
(Executive Order of Removal)

WHEREAS, Catherine Peterson, is presently serving as a Notary Public of the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, on or about September 25, 2012, Catherine Peterson was convicted in the circuit court of the Ninth Judicial Circuit of Florida, in and for Orange County, in case number 2011CF011356, of DWI Manslaughter, a felony offense pursuant to Section 316.193(3)(c)3., Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, a public official convicted of a felony offense may be removed from office by executive order of the Governor, pursuant to Section 112.52(3), Florida Statutes; and


WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the citizens of the State of Florida, that Catherine Peterson be immediately removed from the public office, which she now holds, upon the grounds set forth in this executive order.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, pursuant to Section 112.52(3), Florida Statutes, issue the following executive order, effective immediately:

Section 1. Catherine Peterson is hereby removed from the public office of Notary Public.
