## OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 13-55 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 13-16)

WHEREAS, the Honorable BRUCE H. COLTON, State Attorney for the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 13-16 to the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges filed against juveniles C.I. and I.M. and William Vassor; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable DAVID A. ARONBERG, State Attorney for the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that there are three violations of probation pending against William Vassor; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable BRUCE H. COLTON, State Attorney for the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment including the additional violations of probation in this matter; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

### Section 1.

Executive Order 13-16 is hereby amended to include the violations of probation pending against William Vassor.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 13-16 is ratified and reaffirmed.
