OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 13-56 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 13-26)

WHEREAS, on February 1, 2013, Executive Order 13-26 was issued assigning WILLIAM EDDINS, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit, to the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit to handle charges pending against Steve Gordon Mears for domestic battery and assault; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 13-26 stated that the charge was filed in Bay County, Florida; however, Steven Gordon Mears was charged in Calhoun County with domestic battery and assault; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.


Executive Order 13-26 is hereby amended to reflect Steve Gordon Mears has been charged, in Calhoun County, with domestic battery and assault.

Section 2.


Except as amended herein, Executive Order 13-26 is ratified and reaffirmed.
