OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 13-57 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 13-18)

WHEREAS, the Honorable JERRY HILL, State Attorney for the Tenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 13-18, to the Twentieth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against S.D., a juvenile, for possession of drug equipment paraphernalia; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable STEPHEN B. RUSSELL, State Attorney for the Twentieth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that the juvenile S.D. has subsequently been charged with carrying a concealed weapon, a misdemeanor; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable JERRY HILL, State Attorney for the Tenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charge in this matter; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 13-18 is hereby amended to include the additional charge of carrying a concealed weapon.

Section 2.


Except as amended herein, Executive Order 13-18 is ratified and reaffirmed.
