EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 13-81

(AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 13-33, AMENDED BY EXECUTIVE ORDER 13-39)

WHEREAS, the Honorable MICHAEL J. SATZ, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 13-33, amended by Executive Order 13-39, to the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Lawrence Ivey for aggravated assault with a deadly weapon and battery; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that Lawrence Ivey was also charged with leaving the scene of an accident with damage/unattended vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable MICHAEL J. SATZ, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charge in this matter; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 13-33, amended by Executive Order 13-39, is hereby amended to include the additional charge of leaving the scene of an accident with damage/unattended vehicle.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 13-33, amended by Executive Order 13-39, is ratified and reaffirmed.
