EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 13-86

(AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 13-44)

WHEREAS, the Honorable BRUCE H. COLTON, State Attorney for the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 13-16 to the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle a charge filed against Michael Sellitti for violation of an injunction for protection against domestic violence; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable DAVID A. ARONBERG, State Attorney for the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that a new charge of violation of an injunction for protection against domestic violence has been filed, Case Number 13MM001101 (Palm Beach County); and

WHEREAS, the Honorable BRUCE H. COLTON, State Attorney for the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment including the additional charge in this matter; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.


Executive Order 13-44 is hereby amended to include the violations of probation pending against Michael Sellitti.
