EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 13-304

(AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 13-309)

WHEREAS, the Honorable BRAD KING, State Attorney for the Fifth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 13-309 to the Seventh Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Michael Vieira and Jonathan Mutchler for multiple felonies in Flagler County; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable R.J. LARIZZA, State Attorney for the Seventh Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that co-defendant Diana Loredo has been charged with giving false information to a law enforcement officer during a felony investigation; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable BRAD KING, State Attorney for the Fifth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the charges pending against Diana Loredo; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 13-309 is hereby amended to include co-defendant Diana Loredo who is charged with giving false information to a law enforcement officer during a felony investigation.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 13-309 is ratified and reaffirmed.
