


**STATE OF FLORIDA**

**EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 14-02**

WHEREAS, Geoffrey Greene, Citrus County Property Appraiser, has passed away; and  
WHEREAS, Article X, Section 3, of the Florida Constitution, and section 114.01(1)(b),  
Florida Statutes, provide that a vacancy in office shall occur upon the death of an incumbent  
public officer; and

WHEREAS, Section 114.01(2), Florida Statutes, provides that the Governor shall file an  
Executive Order with the Secretary of State setting forth the facts giving rise to a vacancy in  
office;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, by virtue of the authority  
vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, declare that due to the death of  
Geoffrey Greene, a vacancy currently exists in the Office of the Citrus County Property  
Appraiser, which I shall fill in compliance with the law.
