### EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 14-126

(Executive Order Rescinding 13-253)

WHEREAS, the notary public commission of Jessika Reyes was suspended by Executive Order 13-253 on September 9, 2013, for her failure to respond to or cooperate with an investigation of misconduct conducted by the Governor's Office, in violation of section 117.01(4)(c), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, Jessika Reyes has agreed to perform remedial action to address the above-referenced violation and resolve the investigation noted above.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in accordance with the Florida Constitution and the laws of the State of Florida, issue the following Executive Order, effective immediately:

Section 1. Executive Order 13-253 is rescinded.

Section 2. Jessika Reyes is required to complete a three-hour notary education course; submit an affidavit affirming that she has read the provisions of Chapter 117, Florida Statutes, and that she knows and understands the duties, responsibilities, limitations, and powers of a notary public; and notify the Department of State, in writing, to update her personal contact information, as required by section 117.01(2), Florida Statutes. Jessika Reyes is further required to provide this Office with proof of completion no later than May 2, 2014.
