WHEREAS, the Honorable Patrick Caddell, who was first elected as a Pinellas County Court Judge in 1986, has passed away; and


WHEREAS, Article X, Section 3, of the Florida Constitution, and Section 114.01(1)(b), Florida Statutes, provide that a vacancy in office shall occur upon the death of an incumbent officer; and

WHEREAS, Section 114.01(2), Florida Statutes, provides that the Governor shall file an Executive Order with the Secretary of State setting forth the facts that give rise to a vacancy in office;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, declare that due to the death of Judge Patrick Caddell, a vacancy exists in the Pinellas County Court, which I shall fill in compliance with the law.
