OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 14-295 (Re Florida Fish and Wildlife Commission)

WHEREAS, in order to introduce Florida's youth to outdoor activities that instill conservation values; and

WHEREAS, in order to encourage Florida's families to enjoy the bountiful hunting and fishing opportunities in Florida;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, as Governor of Florida, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Florida Constitution and by all other applicable laws, promulgate the following Executive Order, to take immediate effect:

Section 1. The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission ("Commission") is authorized to temporarily offer the resident lifetime sportsman's license to Florida residents five to twenty-one years of age for a reduced license fee of \$500.

Section 2. The reduced fee shall be offered from November 24, 2014 through December 31, 2014.
