EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 15-106

(AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 15-58)

WHEREAS, the Honorable ED BRODSKY, State Attorney for the Twelfth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 15-58 to the Twentieth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle a case pending against Ryan C. Knaby for driving under the influence; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable STEPHEN B. RUSSELL, State Attorney for the Twentieth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that Ryan C. Knaby has subsequently been arrested for driving under the influence; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable ED BRODSKY, State Attorney for the Twelfth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional allegation in this matter; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.


Executive Order 15-58, is hereby amended to include the additional charge of driving under the influence made against Ryan C. Knaby.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 15-58 is ratified and reaffirmed.


