EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 15-107

WHEREAS, the Honorable PHIL ARCHER, State Attorney for the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was previously assigned by Executive Order 14-168 to the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to represent the State of Florida concerning an investigation involving Brandi Colton for fraudulent issuance of driver's licenses and vehicle registrations; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 14-168 was amended by Executive Order 15-96 to add co-defendants Joseph Miller, David Miller, and Izzat Khatib; and

WHEREAS, the Assigned State Attorney has advised the Governor that the duties required by the previous executive assignment have not yet been completed. While all four defendants have had their cases resolved, defendant Issat Khatib has now been charged with violation of probation; and

WHEREAS, the Assigned State Attorney has further advised the Governor that an extension of this assignment is necessary in order to complete the assigned duties; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the State of Florida and of the ends of justice that the assignment of the Assigned State Attorney be continued with respect to the above matters, pursuant to section 27.14, Florida Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue the following Executive Order:

Section 1.

Executive Order 14-168, as amended by Executive Order 15-96, is reaffirmed and the executive assignment is extended for an additional period of one (1) year, to and including May 15, 2016.

Section 2.

The Assigned State Attorney shall notify the Governor on or before April 15, 2016, if additional time is required.


