EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 15-120

(AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 15-66)

WHEREAS, the Honorable DAVID A. ARONBERG, State Attorney for the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 15-66 to the Twentieth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle cases pending against Stacey Scuderi for violation of injunction against repeat violence, leaving the scene of an accident, two counts of burglary of an occupied dwelling, burglary of a conveyance, grand theft, petit theft, and retail petit theft; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable STEPHEN B. RUSSELL, State Attorney for the Twentieth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that Stacey Scuderi has subsequent allegations of burglary of an unoccupied dwelling and grand theft at two residences; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable DAVID A. ARONBERG, State Attorney for the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional allegation in this matter; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 15-66, is hereby amended to include the additional allegations of burglary of an unoccupied dwelling and grand theft at two residences made against Stacey Lee Scuderi.

Section 2.


Except as amended herein, Executive Order 15-66 is ratified and reaffirmed.
