EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 15-151

WHEREAS, the Honorable MARK A. OBER, State Attorney for the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has advised Governor RICK SCOTT that Dennis Edmond Neeley has filed a motion for post-conviction relief; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable ED BRODSKY, State Attorney for the Twelfth Judicial of Florida, prosecuted the original case for which Dennis Edmond Neeley seeks post-conviction relief under Executive Orders 09-257, 11-70, and 11-220; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable MARK A. OBER has also advised the Governor that the original conflict continues to exist, as Dennis Edmond Neeley is related to employees of the state attorney's office; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable MARK A. OBER, to avoid a conflict of interest or any appearance of impropriety, has voluntarily disqualified himself and has requested the executive assignment of another State Attorney with respect to the motion for post-conviction relief and all related matters; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable ED BRODSKY, State Attorney for the Twelfth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept an executive assignment in this matter; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the State of Florida and of the ends of justice that the Honorable ED BRODSKY discharge the duties of the Honorable MARK A. OBER, pursuant to section 27.14, Florida Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue the following Executive Order, effective immediately:

Section 1.

The Honorable ED BRODSKY, State Attorney for the Twelfth Judicial Circuit of Florida, referred to as the "Assigned State Attorney," is assigned to discharge the duties of the Honorable MARK A. OBER, State Attorney for the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, as they relate to the motion for post-conviction relief and all matters related to Dennis Edmond Neeley.

Section 2.

The Assigned State Attorney or one or more Assistant State Attorneys and Investigators, who have been designated by the Assigned State Attorney, shall proceed immediately to the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, and are vested with the authority to perform the duties prescribed herein.

Section 3.

All residents of the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit are requested, and all public officials are directed, to cooperate and render whatever assistance is necessary to the Assigned State Attorney, so that justice may be served.

Section 4.

The period of this Executive Assignment shall be for one (1) year, to and including August 4, 2016.

Section 5.

The Assigned State Attorney shall notify the Governor on or before July 4, 2016, if additional time is required.
