EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 15-156

(AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDERS 15-66 AND 15-120)

WHEREAS, the Honorable DAVID A. ARONBERG, State Attorney for the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Orders 15-66 and 15-120 to the Twentieth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle complaints filed against Stacy Lee Scuderi; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable STEPHEN B. RUSSELL, State Attorney for the Twentieth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has advised Governor Rick Scott that there are now additional allegations of burglary of an occupied dwelling, grand theft, and criminal mischief; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable DAVID A. ARONBERG has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional allegations in this matter; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue the following Executive Order, effective immediately:

Section 1.


Executive Order 15-66, as amended by Executive Order 15-120, is hereby amended to include the additional allegations of burglary of an occupied dwelling, grand theft, and criminal mischief.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 15-66, as amended by Executive Order 15-120, is ratified and reaffirmed.


