## OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 15-181 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 15-84)

WHEREAS, the Honorable R.J. LARIZZA, State Attorney for the Seventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 15-84 to the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Sarah Michelle Ortiz for burglary, grand theft, and dealing in stolen property as well as charges pending against co-defendants Scott Main and Corey Justice; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable PHIL ARCHER, State Attorney for the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that Sarah Michelle Ortiz has been arrested for misdemeanor domestic battery and in another case there is an allegation pending against her for violation of conditions of release; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable R.J. LARIZZA, State Attorney for the Seventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charge and allegation in these matters; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 15-84 is hereby amended to include the additional charge of misdemeanor domestic battery filed against Sarah Michelle Ortiz and also an allegation of violation of conditions of release.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 15-84 is ratified and reaffirmed.
