OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 15-29 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 15-19)

WHEREAS, the Honorable MARK A. OBER, State Attorney for the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 15-19 to the Twelfth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle an allegation pending against James Rawe; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable ED BRODSKY, State Attorney for the Twelfth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that there is now an additional allegation against James Rawe for grand theft in Manatee County; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable MARK A. OBER, State Attorney for the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional allegation in this matter; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 15-19, is hereby amended to include the additional allegation of grand theft made against James Rawe.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 15-19 is ratified and reaffirmed.
