WHEREAS, Shirley Goff was appointed to the Florida Interagency Coordinating Council for Infants and Toddlers on May 27, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Article X, Section 3, of the Florida Constitution, and Section 114.01(1)(b) Florida Statutes, provide that a vacancy in office shall occur upon the officer's unexplained absence for sixty consecutive days; and

WHEREAS, Shirley Goff last attended a meeting of the Florida Interagency Coordinating Council for Infants and Toddlers prior to January 29, 2013; and

WHEREAS, repeated attempts to contact Shirley Goff have proved unsuccessful; and

WHEREAS, Section 114.01(2), Florida Statutes, provides that the Governor shall file an Executive Order with the Secretary of State setting forth the facts that give rise to a vacancy in office.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, declare that due to Shirley Goff's sixty days of unexplained consecutive absence from office, a vacancy exists on the Florida Interagency Coordinating Council for Infants and Toddlers.
