OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 15-78 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 15-76)

WHEREAS, the Honorable MICHAEL J. SATZ, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 15-76 to the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle a case pending against Adrian R. Shaw for battery; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable DAVID A. ARONBERG, State Attorney for the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that there is an additional allegation pending against Adrian R. Shaw for violation of probation; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable MICHAEL J. SATZ, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional allegation in this matter; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.


Executive Order 15-76, is hereby amended to include the additional allegation of violation of probation made against Adrian R. Shaw.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 15-76 is ratified and reaffirmed.
