### EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 15-86

WHEREAS, at all times material to this Order, Michael Andrew White (White) was a member of the Town Commission of the Town of Inglis, in Levy County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, on January 10, 2014, the State Attorney for the Eighth Judicial Circuit charged White by information with commercial littering, as prohibited by section 403.413(4) & (6)(c), Florida Statutes, and with reckless pollution, as prohibited by section 403.161(1)(a) & (4), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, a violation of section 403.413(4) & (6)(c), constitutes a felony; and

WHEREAS, section 112.51(2), Florida Statutes, provides that the Governor may suspend from office any elected municipal officer who is informed against for the commission of a felony; and

WHEREAS, by Executive Order 14-192, amended by Executive Order 14-193, White was suspended from office as a member of the Town Commission of the Town of Inglis, effective June 23, 2014; and

WHEREAS, on April 22, 2015, the State Attorney for the Eighth Judicial Circuit entered a *nolle prosequi* on the commercial littering charge, White entered a plea of *nolo contendere* on the reckless pollution charge, a misdemeanor, and the Circuit Court of the Eighth Judicial Circuit in Levy County withheld adjudication on the reckless pollution charge.


NOW THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, pursuant to section Article IV, Section 7(a), Florida Constitution and section 112.51, Florida Statutes, issue this Executive Order:

Section 1. Michael Andrew White is hereby reinstated to the public office that he held at the time of the above-mentioned suspension, to-wit: member of the Town Commission of the Town of Inglis.

Section 2. Executive Orders 14-192 and 14-193 are hereby revoked and the suspension of Michael Andrew White is terminated.
