OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 16-179 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 16-165)

WHEREAS, the Honorable MICHAEL J. SATZ, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 16-165 to the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Dale Lamar Hardnette; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 16-165 incorrectly referenced the defendant as Dale Hardnett, instead of by his correct name of Dale Lamar Hardnette; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable DAVID ARONBERG, State Attorney for the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has advised Governor Rick Scott that Dale Lamar Hardnette, has two co-defendants, Shakara Monik Martin and Gabrielle Quintesha Byrd, both charged with false and fraudulent insurance claims; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable MICHAEL J. SATZ has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the charges pending against Shakara Monik Martin and Gabrielle Quintesha Byrd; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 16-165 is hereby amended to include charges filed against co-defendants Shakara Monik Martin and Gabrielle Quintesha Byrd and to correct the name of Dale Lamar Hardnette.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 16-165 is ratified and reaffirmed.
