OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 16-181 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 16-70)

WHEREAS, the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 16-70 to the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Brahmanand Hardat; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable MICHAEL J. SATZ, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that Brahmanand Hardat has additionally been charged with DUI (5th Offense); DUI (2nd Refusal); driving while driver's license revoked with knowledge; leaving the scene of an accident with property damage; and failure to use due care; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charges; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.


Executive Order 16-70 is hereby amended to include the additional charges DUI (5th Offense); DUI (2nd Refusal); driving while driver's license revoked with knowledge; leaving the scene of an accident with property damage; and failure to use due care.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 16-70 is ratified and reaffirmed.
