OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 16-187 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 16-85)

WHEREAS, the Honorable GLENN HESS, State Attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was previously assigned by Executive Order 16-85 to the First Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Jason Andrew McKendry for grand theft, trespassing, dealing in stolen property by trafficking, and violation of probation; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable WILLIAM EDDINS, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that Jason Andrew McKendry has a new charge of grand theft under Case No. 462016CF0001614 in Okaloosa County; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable GLENN HESS, State Attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charge in these matters; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.


Executive Order 16-85 is hereby amended to include the additional charge of grand theft filed against Jason Andrew McKendry.

Section 2.


Except as amended herein, Executive Order 16-85 is ratified and reaffirmed.
