STATE OF FLORIDA OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 16-196

WHEREAS, the Honorable R.J. LARIZZA, State Attorney for the Seventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, was previously assigned by Executive Order 15-174 to the Fourth Judicial Circuit of Florida to represent the State of Florida concerning charges pending against Michael Anthony Gant III, Angelina Nichole Green, and Dreren Anthony Williams; and

WHEREAS, the Assigned State Attorney has advised the Governor that the duties required by the previous executive assignment have not yet been completed as Dreren Anthony Williams has other cases pending in St. Johns County and in Duval County. In St. Johns County he was just appointed another attorney, which has caused a delay. The cases against Angelina Nichole Green, and Michael Anthony Grant have been resolved; and

WHEREAS, the Assigned State Attorney has further advised the Governor that an extension of this assignment is necessary in order to complete the assigned duties; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the State of Florida and of the ends of justice that the assignment of the Assigned State Attorney be continued with respect to the above matters, pursuant to section 27.14, Florida Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue the following Executive Order: Section 1.

Executive Order 15-174 is reaffirmed and the executive assignment is extended for an additional period of one (1) year, to and including August 9, 2017.

Section 2.

The Assigned State Attorney shall notify the Governor on or before July 9, 2017, if additional time is required.
