OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 16-20 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 15-244)

WHEREAS, the Honorable GLENN HESS, State Attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 15-244 to the First Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Ronald Eugene Hoffman for battery and resisting arrest without violence; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable WILLIAM EDDINS, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that, as a result of these charges, Ronald Eugene Hoffman now has a violation of probation from a previous case; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable GLENN HESS, State Attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charge and allegation in these matters; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.


Executive Order 15-244 is hereby amended to include the additional allegation of violation of probation filed against Ronald Eugene Hoffman.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 15-244 is ratified and reaffirmed.
