## STATE OF FLORIDA OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 16-247 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 16-116)

WHEREAS, the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 16-116 to the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Louis Andrew Altemar; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable MICHAEL J. SATZ, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that Louis Andrew Altemar has now been arrested for robbery with a weapon; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable KATHERINE FERNANDEZ RUNDLE, State Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charges; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

## Section 1.

Executive Order 16-116 is hereby amended to include the additional charge of robbery with a weapon.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 16-116 is ratified and reaffirmed.
