OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 16-279 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 16-256)

WHEREAS, the Honorable MICHAEL J. SATZ, State Attorney for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 16-256 to the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Brandon Westcott and Ramono Lee Brown; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable DAVID ARONBERG, State Attorney for the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has advised Governor Rick Scott that it has been discovered that an additional codefendant, Shawn Paul Damico, has been charged with dealing in stolen property and false verification of ownership - second hand dealer; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable DAVID ARONBERG has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the charges pending against co-defendant Shawn Paul Damico; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.


Executive Order 16-256 is hereby amended to include charges filed against co-defendant Shawn Paul Damico for dealing in stolen property and false verification of ownership – second hand dealer.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 16-256 is ratified and reaffirmed.
