OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 16-28 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 15-195)

WHEREAS, the Honorable PHIL ARCHER, State Attorney for the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 15-195 to the Seventh Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Christopher John Smith for violation of probation; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable R.J. LARIZZA, State Attorney for the Seventh Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that, Christopher John Smith has a new charge of grand theft of a motor vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable PHIL ARCHER, State Attorney for the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charge in these matters; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 15-195 is hereby amended to include the additional charge of grand theft of a motor vehicle filed against Christopher John Smith.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 15-195 is ratified and reaffirmed.
