OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 16-280 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 16-244)

WHEREAS, the Honorable WILLIAM EDDINS, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 16-244 to the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Kevin E. Wood for disorderly intoxication; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable GLENN HESS, State Attorney for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that Kevin E. Wood has subsequently been arrested for driving under the influence (case number 032016CT03889A) and for resisting an officer without violence (case number 032016MM07130A); and

WHEREAS, the Honorable WILLIAM EDDINS, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charges; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.



Except as amended herein, Executive Order 16-244 is ratified and reaffirmed.


