EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 17-13

(Amending Executive Order 17-12)

WHEREAS, on January 12, 2017, Executive Order 17-12 was issued assigning the Honorable PHIL ARCHER, State Attorney for the Eighteenth Circuit, to the Seventh Judicial Circuit to handle a criminal complaint filed against Stacy Elaine Kircher by the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, Office of Agricultural Law Enforcement, for Forged or Simulated Official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection and Criminal Use of Personal Identification; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 17-12 should reflect that the Honorable MELISSA W. NELSON, State Attorney for the Fourth Judicial Circuit has been assigned to discharge the duties of the Honorable R.J. Larizza, State Attorney for the Seventh Judicial Circuit to represent the State of Florida concerning a complaint pending against Stacy Elaine Kircher;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 17-12 is amended to reflect that the Honorable MELISSA W. NELSON, State Attorney for the Fourth Judicial Circuit, is assigned to discharge the

duties of the Honorable R.J. LARIZZA, State Attorney for the Seventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, regarding a complaint filed against Stacy Elaine Kircher.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 17-12 is ratified and reaffirmed.
