## OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 17-19 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 16-197)

WHEREAS, the State Attorney for the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 16-197 to the Twelfth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against Devante Brown for two counts of felon in possession of a firearm, two counts of aggravated assault with a firearm, and aggravated assault; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable ED BRODSKY, State Attorney for the Twelfth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that Devante Brown has been arrested in two additional cases, in which he is charged with aggravated stalking and possession with intent to sell or deliver heroin within 1,000 feet of a convenience business; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable ANDREW H. WARREN, State Attorney for the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charges and allegations in these matters; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 16-197 is hereby amended to include the additional allegations of aggravated stalking, and possession with intent to sell or deliver heroin within 1,000 feet of a convenience business.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 16-197 is ratified and reaffirmed.
