OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 17-208 (AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 17-185)

WHEREAS, the State Attorney for the Twelfth Judicial Circuit of Florida, was assigned by Executive Order 17-185 to the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida to handle charges pending against George Zachary Chronister for violation of stalking injunctions; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable ANDREW H. WARREN, State Attorney for the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit, has advised Governor Rick Scott that a new criminal report affidavit has been filed against George Zachary Chronister for contempt of court violation of stalking injunction; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable ED BRODSKY, State Attorney for the Twelfth Judicial Circuit of Florida, has agreed to accept the executive assignment to include the additional charges and allegations in these matters; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICK SCOTT, Governor of Florida, in obedience to my solemn constitutional duty to "take care that the laws be faithfully executed," and pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Florida, do hereby issue the following Executive Order effective immediately:

Section 1.

Executive Order 17-185 is hereby amended to include the additional allegations of contempt of court violation of stalking injunction.

Section 2.

Except as amended herein, Executive Order 17-185 is ratified and reaffirmed.
